I just want to remind hog feeders to keep plenty of bedding for the pigs to stay warm. Also, feed a little extra as the pigs need feed to maintain energy and keep warm. A heat lamp is also good to help on these really cold days, but don't get it to low so the pigs can reach it as it could cause a fire.

Continue to prepare for the cold weather With heat lamps and blankets. I suggest spraying the pens prior to putting down shaving then after you are through showing please spray sheep with Kaptan and Goats with sulfur dip. I am not sure that it will kill all of the itch but I know it won't hurt. The fair grounds are full of both and if precautions are not taken your lambs or goats will pick them up.
