

# Smithson Valley FFA Shooting Team 2023-2024 Shooter Agreement / Safety Contract 

All shooters must have basic knowledge of their shotgun and have attended an SV safety meeting when initially joining the team. Returning members who participated in a minimum of 3 events are not required to attend this year's initial SV meeting. Every shooter is held accountable to follow all safety rules and regulations.

Event safety meetings are the responsibility of the shooter to attend, even if the event claims it is optional. Safety is our utmost importance and will be taken seriously. If a shooter is discovered to have skipped a shoot safety meeting without discussion with team management, this could be grounds for dismissal from the team.

- All shooters must have their Hunters Ed certification.
- All shooters must be an FFA member and in an ag class for the full calendar school year.
- UIL eligibility rules apply, no exceptions.
- No referrals or suspensions- results in automatic removal from the team.
- Safety violations will result in removal from the team.
- No throwing shells/hulls or displays of anger/aggression- 1 warning only
- No threats, personal or on social media. Automatic removal \& permanent ban from the team.
- No disrespect to adults, teachers, administration or staff.
- No weapons or ammunition is ever allowed on campus. Immediate removal from the team and proper authorities will be contacted.
- A parent or guardian must attend all events with you.
- No airpods or noise canceling devices may be used as hearing protection.


## FFA State Shoot Team Qualifications

- Must have their Hunters Ed certification
- Be enrolled or have taken Wildlife- Ag 381 (open to sophomores and above)
- Minimum of 4 team events before April 1st.
