



Dear Smokin Clays Shootout and BBQ Cookoff participant,

We want to thank you for taking the time to participate in our commitment to provide scholarships to our seniors, supplies to the FFA classes, and teachers. Your involvement helps the SV FFA stay on the leading edge of learning. Your participation in the Smokin Clays Shootout and BBQ Cookoff will make a positive difference to our members, all those in our community who care about the development of young people, and to the future of agriculture and agricultural education.

Below are some helpful tips for the shoot. please take a moment to look this over.

- **What do I bring?**
 - Shotgun – Semi-Auto or Over/Under is recommended.
 - **Eye and ear protection is mandatory for your safety!**
 - Shell pouch
 - 5 boxes of shells for the course and some extra boxes if you plan on shooting Flurry after the shoot. Flurry is a two-person competition and it's a ball!!
 - You or your guest may bring a personal ATV, but **all shooting teams** will get a four-seat golf cart.
- **When do I arrive for registration and what to expect?**
 - This will be a 100 bird Sporting Clay Shoot. 10 stations with 10 pairs per station.
 - 7:30 starts registration. You will get an envelope with your wrist band, complimentary door prize ticket, and goodie bag.
 - Safety brief starts at 8:45 and the shoot starts at 9:00.
 - Raffle items will be available for purchase before and during the shoot. **Raffle tickets are \$20 each. Buy five & get one free. Buy ten and get three free. Bucket raffle at the shoot are \$10 each. Buy ten get one free. We would greatly appreciate your participation!**
 - Bison coolers and tumblers for the sponsors that qualify.
 - BBQ meal tickets for shooters. Non-shooting guest may also enjoy the wonderful BBQ lunch by Holy Smokes. Meal tickets for guest are \$15 each. **Please reserve!**
 - BYOB for those over 21. You will get a wrist band based on age at check-in.
 - There will be two stations on each course to solve any team or HOA tiebreakers. If those two stations don't solve the tiebreakers, there will be a shoot-off until we have a winner.
